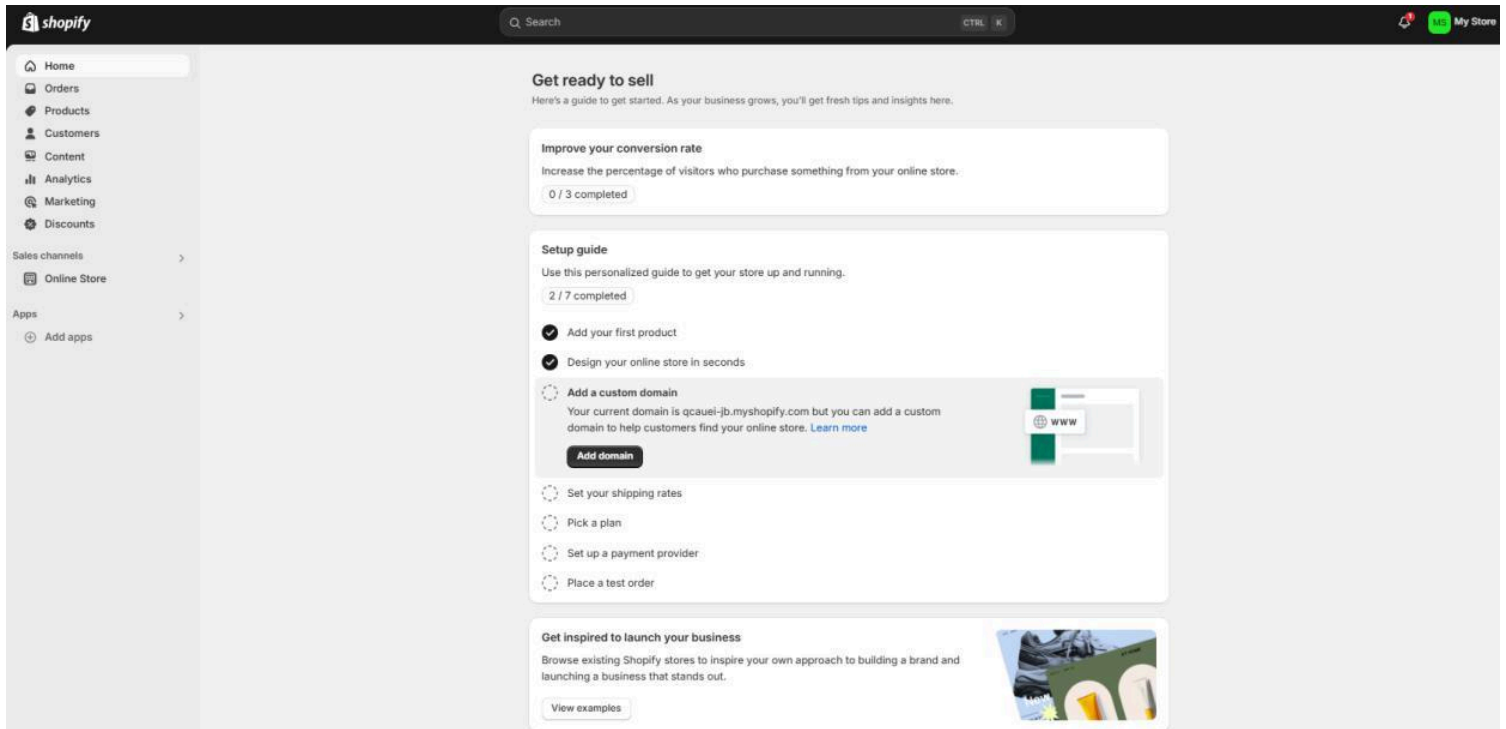
I) Essential Files and Plugins for Shopify Integration

To successfully integrate the tryon feature with Shopify, the following files and plugins are required -

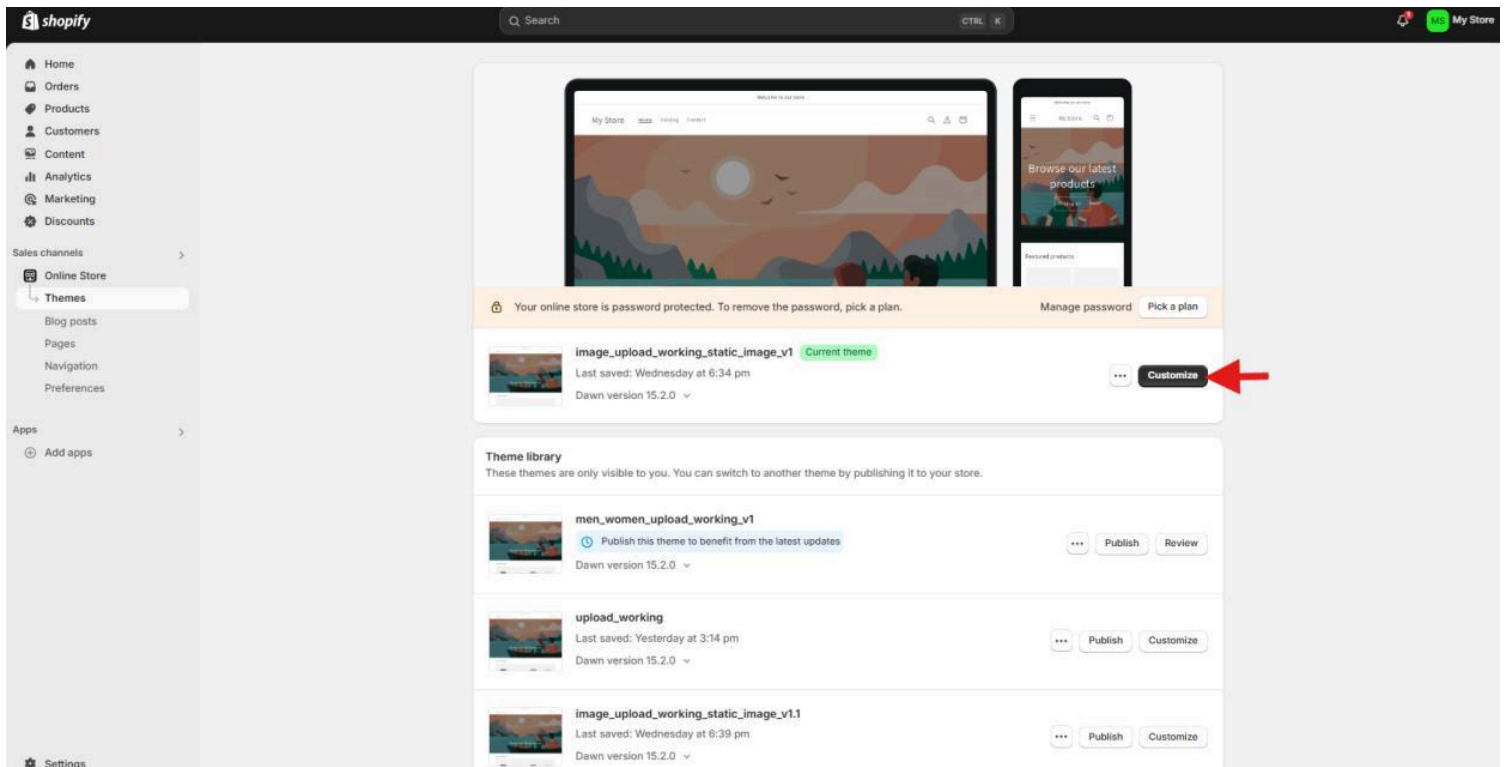
1.	Theme.liquid

II) Integrate CDN and Custom JS

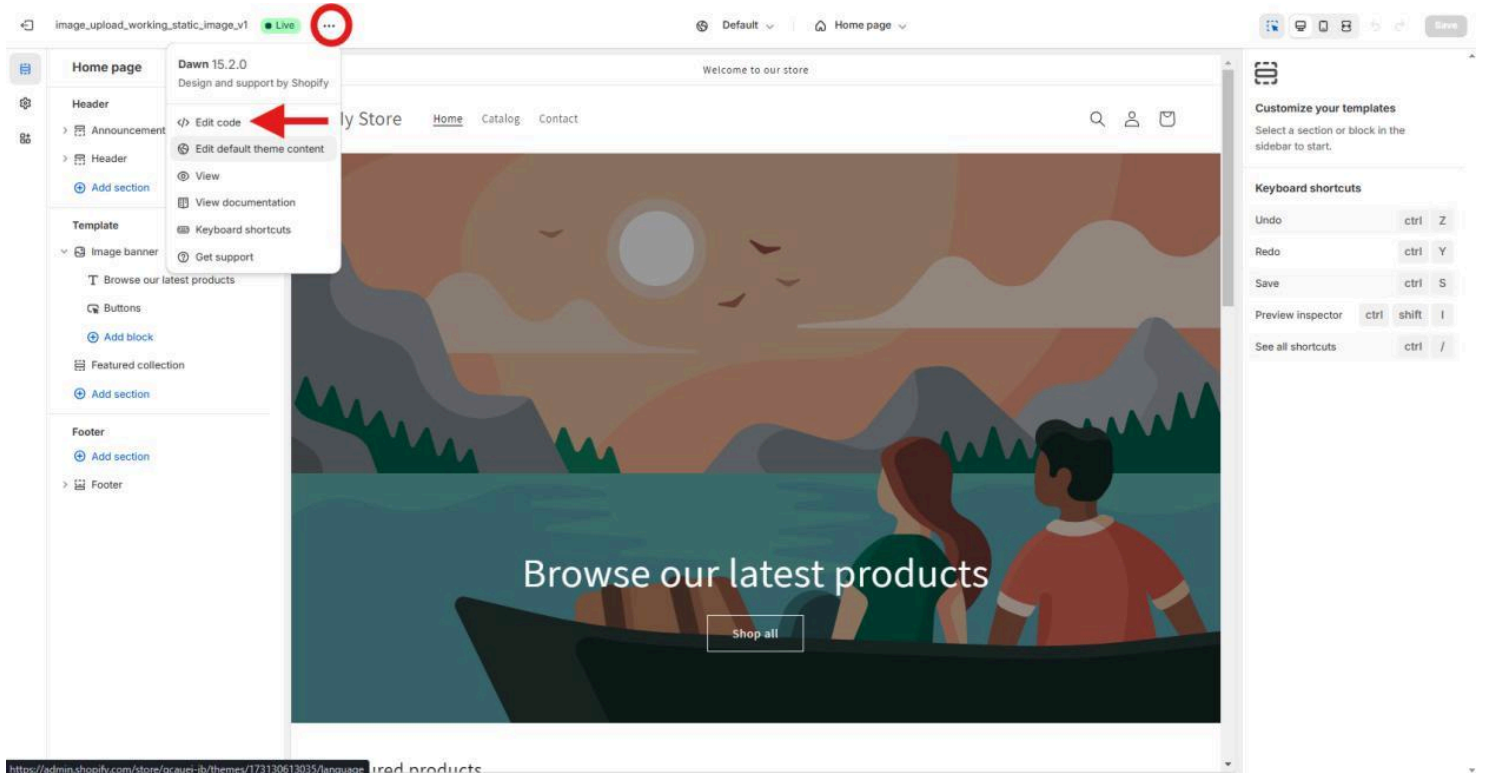
Step 1: Go to your Shopify admin site.



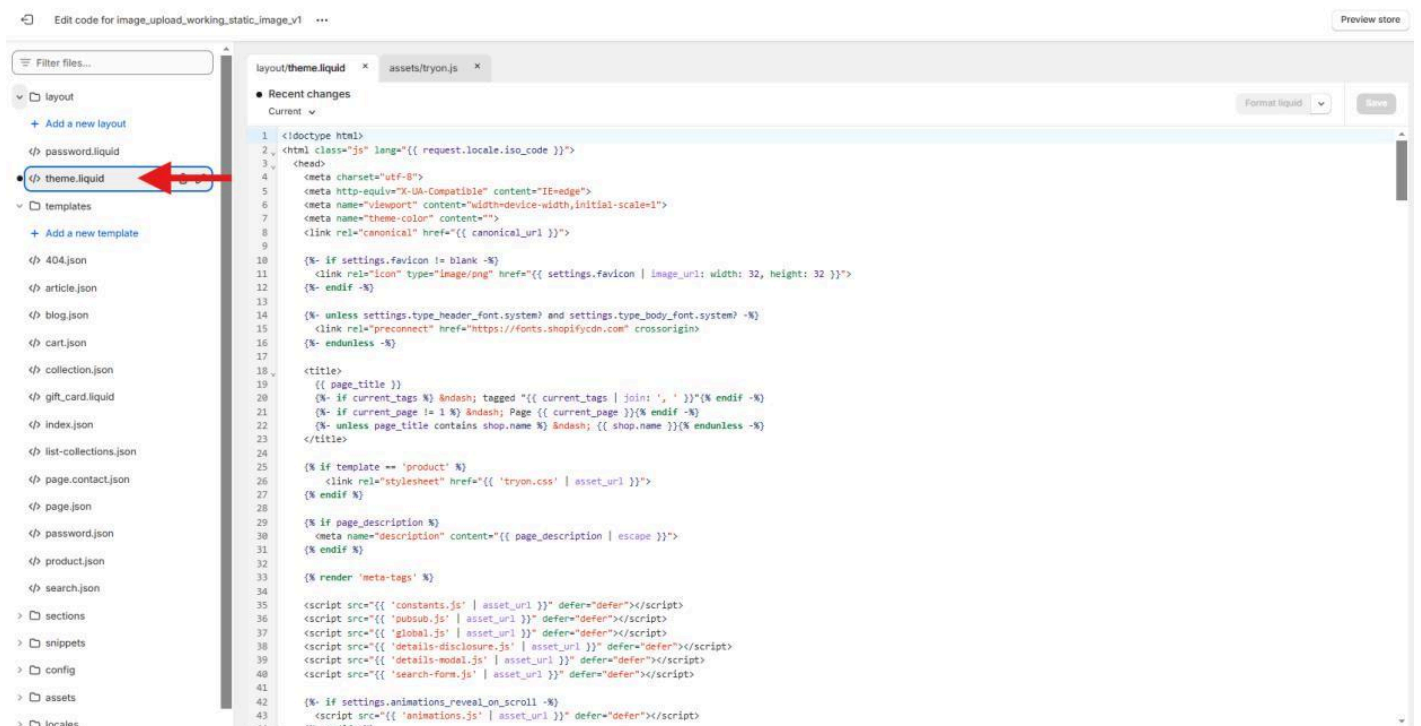
Step 2: Click on Online Store then click on “Customize”



Step 3: Click on “Edit code”

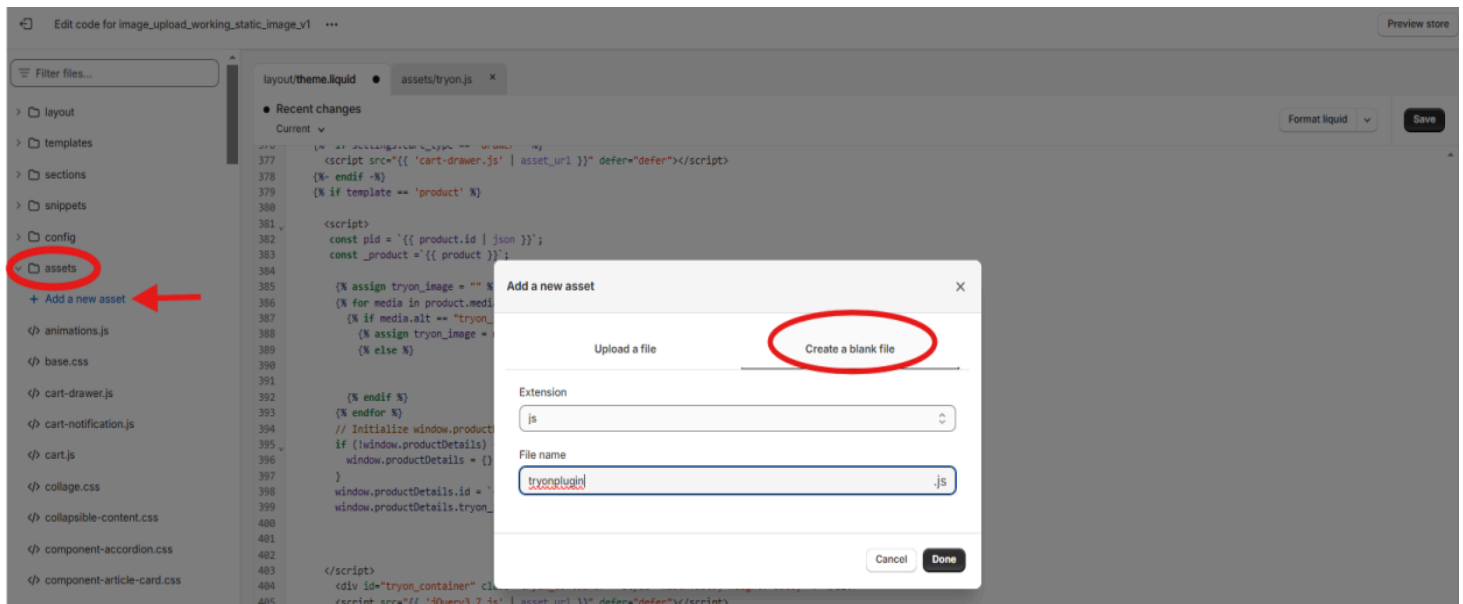


Step 4: Click on “{/} theme. Liquid



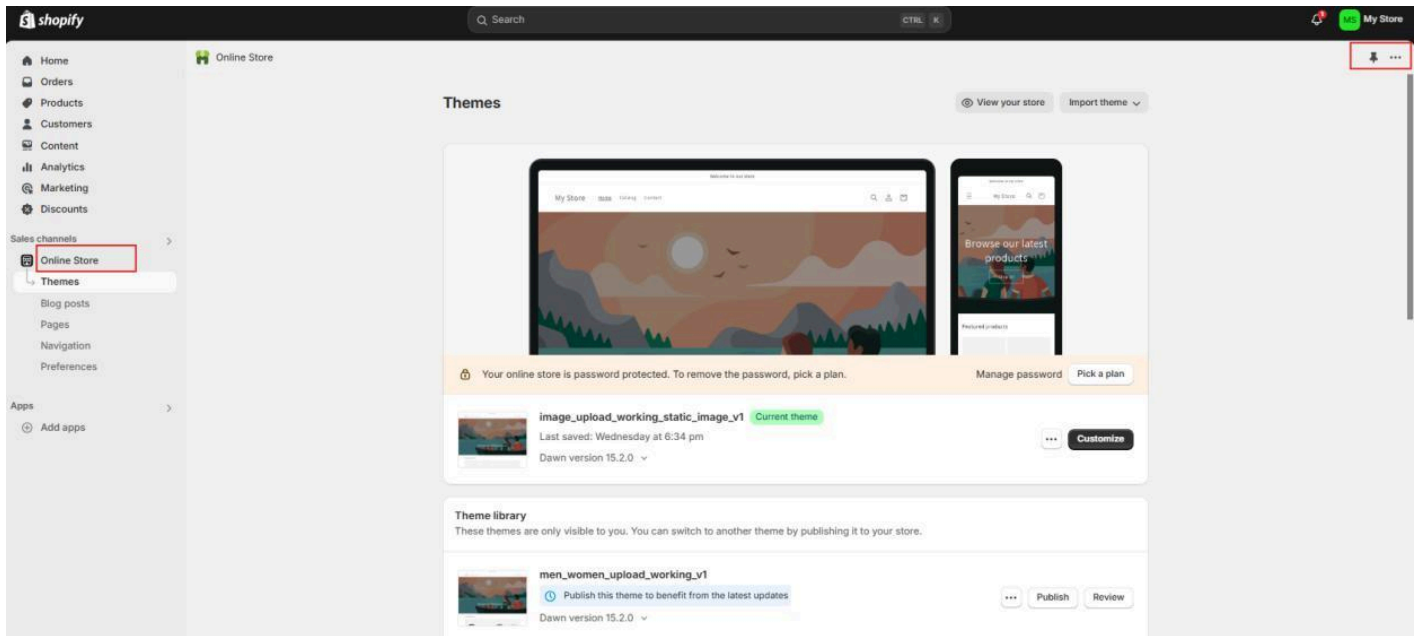
Step 5. Creating Custom JS file

 - ❖ File name-jQuery3.7 and select extension js

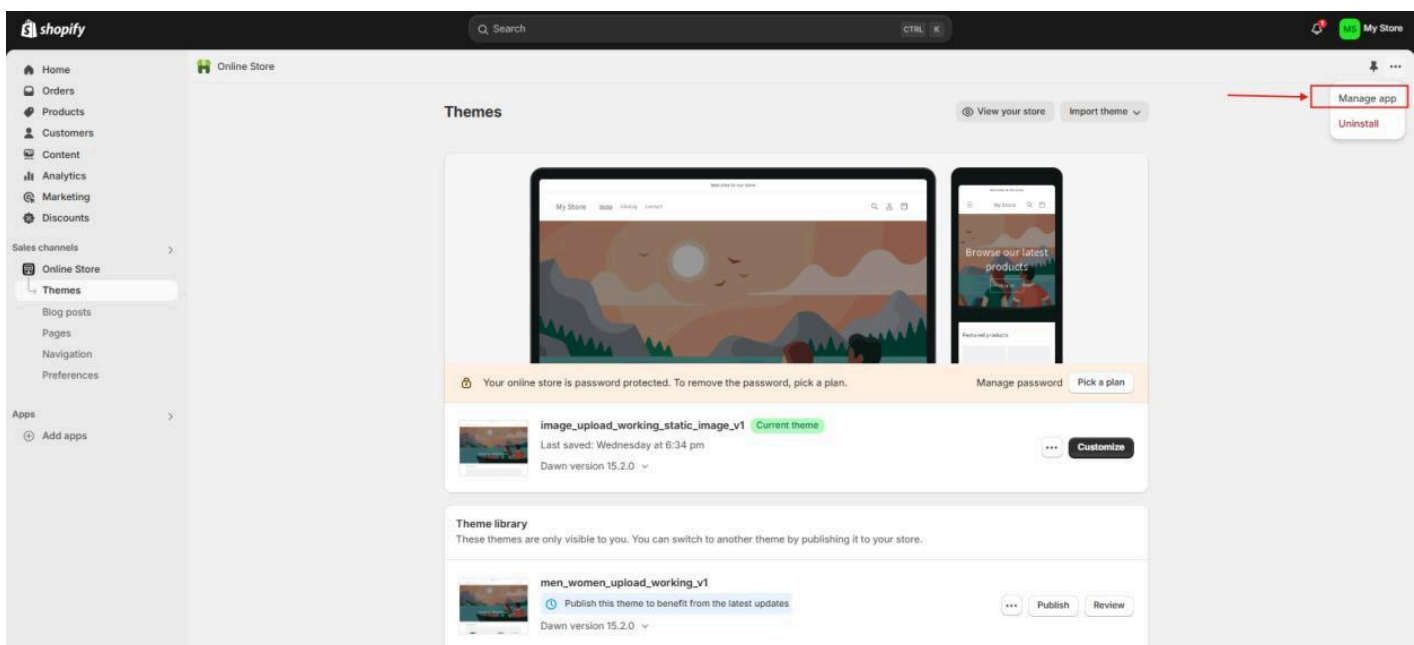

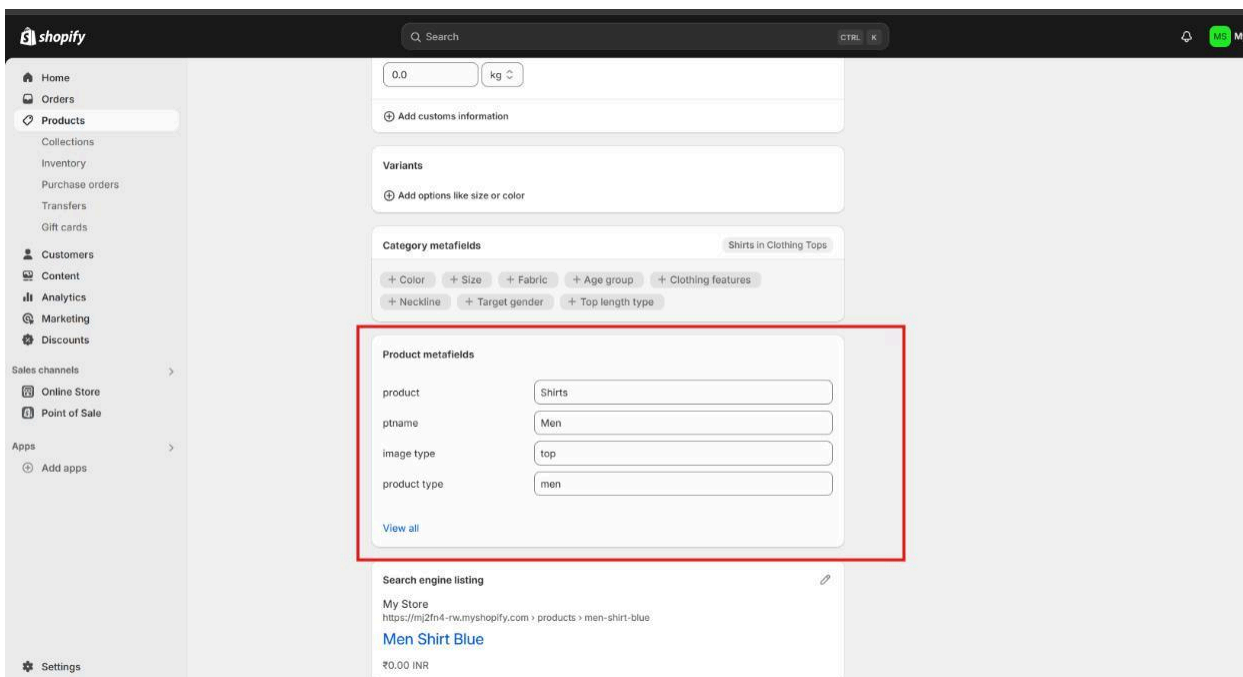

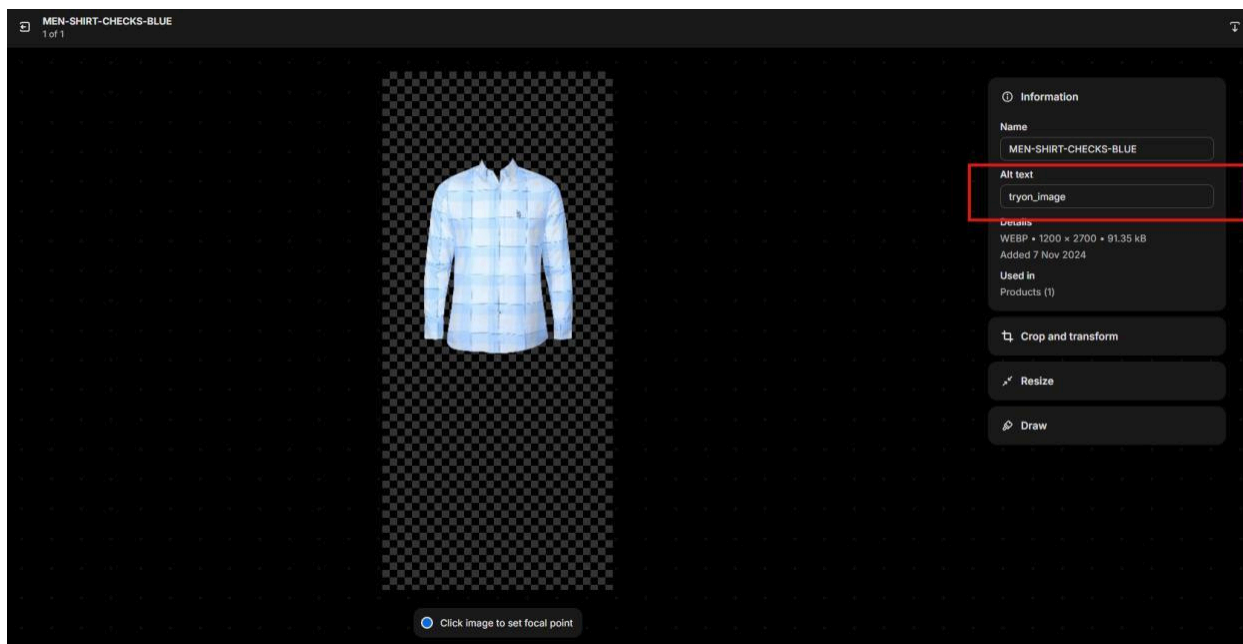

Clicking on Tryon button will pop up Tryon window right bottom corner



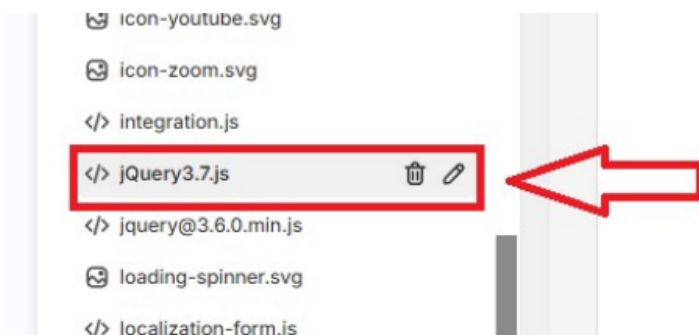

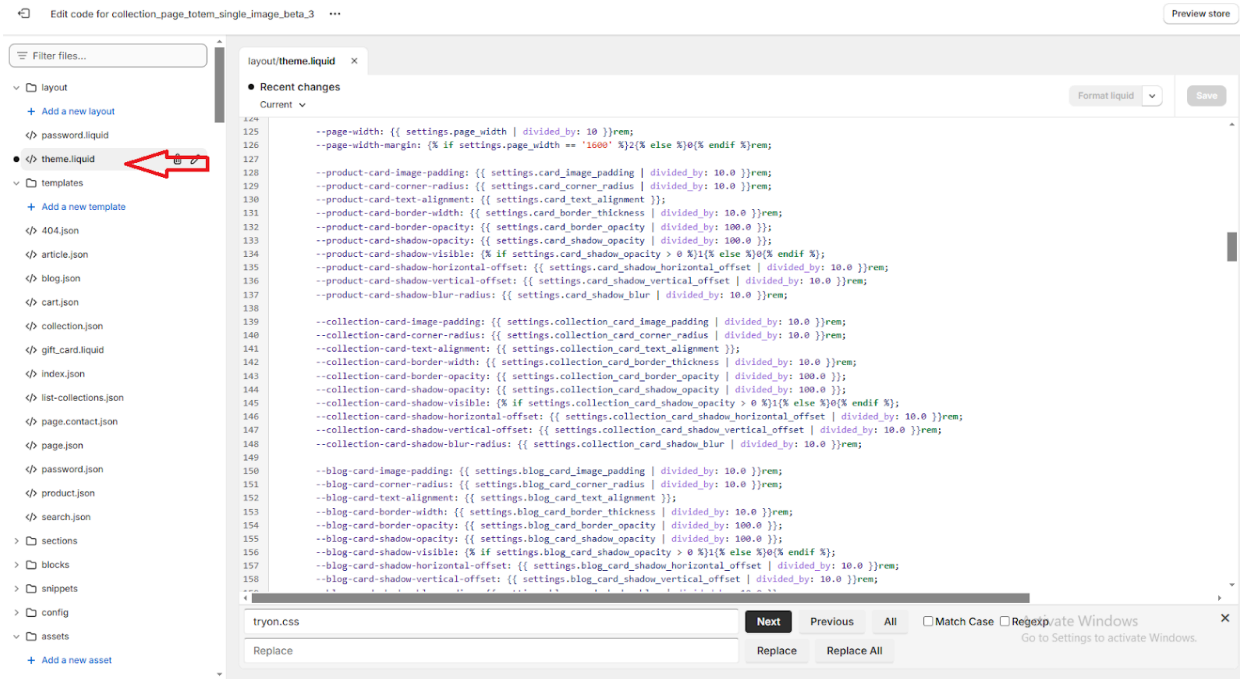

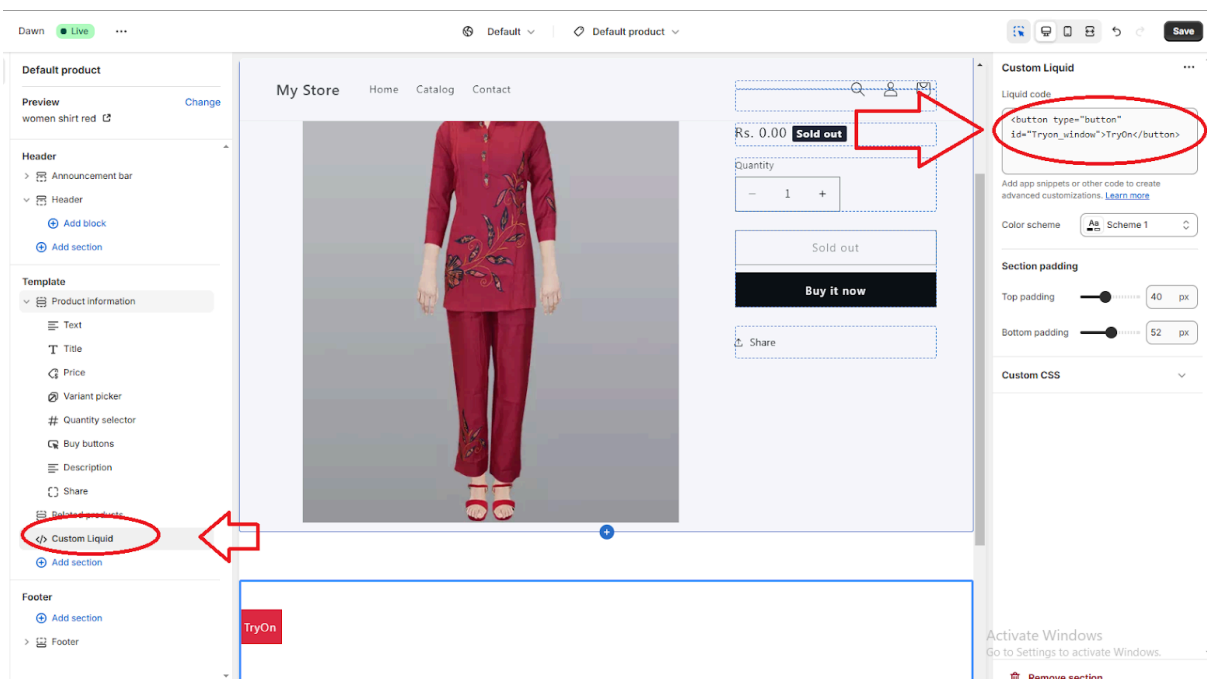


VIII) Add Tryon Button in Shopify webpage
